New York, NY, February 23, 2010 – Hope For The Warriors® presents Above & Beyond™, a professional course developed to assist wounded service members transition into a new phase of their career by providing professional tools and one-on-one guidance. This seminar will help each participant pinpoint their strengths and discover how those strengths can be utilized in the civilian or government sectors as well as opportunities to further their education. This course is open to all wounded service members, including active duty members.

All expenses for the course, including travel to New York, lodging, and meals are provided by Hope For The Warriors® in partnership with Crown Ford of Lynbrook, NY and Michael Stapleton Associates. Hope For The Warriors® is a non-profit organization dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for U.S. Service Members and their families who have been adversely affected by injuries or death in the line of duty.

The program is comprised of two sessions; Session One is March 18 - 21 and Session Two is April 8 – 12. In Session One, participants will identify strengths and weaknesses, inventory accomplishments, and pinpoint life and career goals. Session Two includes individualized coaching on specific skills to include interview preparation, resume building, business etiquette and writing, corporate technology, networking techniques, and many other topics. Both sessions are highly interactive and include classes, speakers, roundtable discussions, role-playing and expose the participants to a variety of career professionals and mentors. Joyce deMoose, Professional Development Director, emphasized, “Each seminar is tailored to the experiences, needs, and goals of the class members.” Class size is limited to approximately 10 per seminar to ensure that each participant has ample one-on-one time to develop their goals and skills.
